WHO, WHAT, & WHY

REVELATION – God Speaks, PT. 2

This week we will continue to consider what God has revealed to His creation. God in His grace has given us an option greater than speculation. It is only through His revelation that we can even begin to know who God is and understand His purposes.

DEFINITION

General Revelation: The personal act of God by which He makes Himself known through His creation, providence, and conscience to humanity in general, so that they might come into relationship with Him.

DEFINITION

Special Revelation: The personal acts of God by which He makes Himself known by His redemptive Word/work to many people so that they might come into relationship with Him.

1. **Read & Consider** 2 Timothy 3:16, Hebrews 1:1

Implications: Consider now, the implications of God's revelation to our daily lives.

2. Give an example of general revelation in your life and how God used it to reveal Himself to you.

3. How has God revealed Himself to you through Scripture in the past week?

4. How does faith in the Word of God affect how you live your life today?

5. What does it mean to you personally to submit to the Authority of Scripture?

6. In what areas of your life have you resisted the Bible's Authority?

7. Give an example of where you see the Word of God living and active today.

8. What is the main thing you learned from these pages?

9. What is the main question that you have that you will bring to your group the next time we meet?

Prayer: Reflect on the truth of God's Word, and who it reveals Him to be. Meditate on the grace of God that He would reveal Himself to us in such a tangible way as Scripture.

Pray for wisdom and an understanding of the revelation of God in my daily Bible study.

Pray that the word of God would be living and active in my life.

Pray for a desire to know God through his Word.

Pray for those you know who have yet to believe; that God's revelation would penetrate their hearts.
